PAYMENT TERMS & PROCEDURES

Automatic Payments

Trip participants may enroll in automatic payments through PCC's payment processing system. ACH bank drafts and credit cards are accepted. Credit cards will incur a 3.49% handling fee. ACH bank drafts will incur a 1.49% handling fee.

Manual Payment

Trip participants can submit cash/check/money order according to the payment schedule.

Click-to-Pay/Electronic Invoicing

Trip participants may enroll in click-to-pay electronic invoices. All click-to-pay invoices will incur a 3.49% processing surcharge.

Late Payments

Accounts which are delinquent for more than 30 days will be automatically assessed a 10% late fee. This fee is compounded for every additional 30 days that an invoice goes unpaid.

Delinquency

Accounts that have an overdue balance greater than 25% of the total amount due per traveler on or before December 15, 2023, will be automatically dropped from the trip with no refund.

TOUR FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES

Several fundraising options throughout the season are scheduled to help singers reduce the cost of their trip. Fundraising can cover 100% of your trip cost if you plan accordingly. Fundraising efforts impact a trip's final balance, so families can expect to pay according to the payment schedule. (In the event of fundraising over the trip price, a refund will be issued in March 2024.)

April-May

Showtime Ticket Fundraiser

- Singers will be able to sell discounted tickets to friends and family
- Significant % of each ticket sold will go toward the singer's tour account
- Singers will be responsible for collecting payment and delivering tickets
- Because final payments will have already been due, singers will receive a refund for the total they earned

CHAPERONE/NON-PERFORMER POLICY

The Pensacola Children's Chorus welcomes parents, family members, and friends to accompany us on this tour. If you are considering joining us on this trip, please review the following information:

CHAPERONE

Chaperones are an essential component of every tour. As an extension of staff leadership, chaperones ensure that PCC's standards of conduct are observed by all singers throughout the tour. Chaperoning is a great way to experience the trip through the eyes of our singers. The best chaperones play a crucial role in cultivating a positive and memorable tour experience.

A family member of a participating singer may serve as a chaperone. Parents/legal guardians are preferred.

A participating singer's family member can serve as a chaperone. Parents/guardians are preferred. Other family members (such as a grandparent, aunt/uncle, or older sibling over the age of 21) may be able to chaperone but must first interview with a member of the PCC staff. Because chaperones serve as caretakers of singers during the trip, they are required to pass a Level 2 background check and are carefully vetted by PCC staff members. If you are interested in becoming a chaperone, **please register for the trip**. You will not be charged until you have been contacted by a PCC staff member.

Please note, **if you wish to accompany your child on the trip, you must register as a chaperone**, not a tagalong. As such, chaperones may not deviate from the scheduled itinerary, nor can they be responsible for any children/family members who are not enrolled as a PCC singer. (This stipulation especially applies to non-enrolled siblings, spouses, or extended family members. Chaperoning is a job, not a vehicle for a family vacation.)

TAGALONG

Parents, friends, and family members are welcome to "tag-along." Tagalongs will travel with PCC to Orlando stay in PCC-selected hotels, enjoy Walt Disney World, and support PCC performances. However, tagalongs may not attach themselves to chaperone groups, nor can they remove a PCC singer from the itinerary at any time. *Tagalong parents are not chaperones and may not interfere with trip activities, singer management, or chaperone authority.*
