



Collegiate Scholarship Information

Class of 2023

In these uncertain times, the Pensacola Children's Chorus is pleased to continue its collegiate scholarship program which aims to recognize the achievements and character of our graduating seniors. These awards will be announced at the annual High School Banquet and publicly shared on PCC's social media platforms.

Any graduating senior* is eligible to apply, provided that they have been a member of PCC for at least one full season (September through May). If selected, funds will be disbursed once proof of enrollment in a fully accredited post-secondary college or university is received.

*Individuals with [Florida Pre-Paid College Funds](#) or [Take Stock in Children](#) scholarships are ineligible for a PCC Scholarship.

*Individuals who have received a [Bright Futures](#) Scholarship are eligible for a PCC Scholarship.

The Spirit of Pensacola Scholarship is awarded to an outstanding graduating senior who best exemplifies the qualities of honor, courage, and commitment. True to the civic and military fabric of Pensacola, the awardee shall be selected and recognized for significant service and leadership in their own community and that of the Pensacola Children's Chorus.

TO APPLY

Interested applicants should submit a written essay (400-500 words) which explains how one has embodied the traits of honor, courage, and commitment through their service to the Pensacola community and the Pensacola Children's Chorus.

Additionally, each applicant should submit a 1-page résumé which outlines one's meaningful musical and/or theatrical performance as well as community service. (Please do not exceed one page.)

No formal application is required. Interested applicants should submit these two artifacts – 1) essay and 2) résumé – electronically to submissions@pensacolasings.org. Please indicate a desire to apply for a collegiate scholarship in the subject and body of the email.

Essays and résumés shall be reviewed by members of the PCC Board of Directors.

Artifacts should be received by no later than **11:59pm on Sunday, April 9, 2023. Late submissions will not be accepted.**
