### COSTUME INFORMATION

- Singers may leave costume items at PCC on Sunday for use on Monday and Tuesday.
- For all performances and rehearsals, singers should arrive with their hair and makeup done in advance to the greatest extent possible, depending on their approved costume look. There will be limited time to get ready in holding rooms.
- Stage lighting tends to wash out facial features. We ask that all singers wear some level of stage make-up. Requirements can be found in the [PCC handbook](#).
- Any special jewelry, nail polish, and accessories must be approved by Mrs. Heidi before they can be worn on stage.
- For Young Singers only: Unless you receive specific instructions from a PCC staff member, please plan to take any PCC-issued costume items home with you after the Tuesday performance for use on Thursday. Singers will be expected to keep these items in good condition and return them to a PCC staff member after the school shows.

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- The Thursday performances will take place during school hours. Young Singers will be performing for thousands of children in Pre-K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade, 54% of whom are economically disadvantaged. PCC understands the importance of academics, and we are grateful to our singers' families for recognizing the positive impact that these performances will have and allowing their child to miss school in order to participate. A school excusal letter is available on the [Singer Site](#) for you to submit to your child's school administration. Thank you for your support in this endeavor.
- Singers are encouraged to **carpool to and from each school**, and PCC staff will help to coordinate carpooling efforts during regular rehearsals. **Apart from credentialed PCC staff members and volunteers, no adults will be permitted to enter the schools with the singers.**
- The breaks between performances have been built in primarily for travel. Singers will not be permitted to stop at restaurants between performances and risk arriving late for their next call time. Instead, singers should **bring food from home** to eat throughout the day. PCC will provide light snacks as well.
- It will be the responsibility of each singer to **transport any costume items** that cannot be safely worn while traveling. Upon arrival at each school, we will have 45 minutes to prepare before the performance begins. Wigs/large hats/other bulky items can be put on at that time.
- These performances were established last season in direct response to feedback from singers, families, and other stakeholders that we should increase our visibility in local schools. Hauntcert 2023 was incredibly well received by the children and teachers in our community, and we are excited to provide this service to our partners in education once again in 2024. We also took singers' and parents' feedback from last year's school performances into account while building this year's Hauntcert schedule, and we are hopeful that the experience will be just as meaningful and impactful for all involved this time around!
