All rehearsals will take place at the SAENGER THEATRE

- Singers and volunteers will enter through the **Stage Door** at the corner of **Jefferson & Intendencia Streets**.
- **Please be ON TIME, but please DO NOT be early.** Staff will not be available to monitor singers prior to the posted call times. Singers will be welcomed inside promptly at their call time, which is generally at least 15 minutes before they are needed on stage. Thank you for your cooperation!
- All singers and volunteers will have to pass through a security screening prior to entry. To expedite the security process and to ensure cleanliness and safety, please **leave nonessential items at home!**
- *Volunteers without appropriate credentials will not be allowed to enter the building.*

Defining PERFORMANCE READY

- Hair must be of a natural color. It should be clean, styled, and secured away from the face. Bangs should be trimmed and must not cover a singer's eyes. Long hair should be pulled back into a "half-up, half-down" look where the hair framing the face is pulled back and secured behind the ears. Curling is not required. Short hair should be well-groomed, free of frizz, and secured out of the face. Modest hair accessories are acceptable provided that they match or blend in with a singer's natural hair color.
- Stage lighting tends to wash out all facial features. We ask that all singers wear some level of stage make-up. RED lipstick is no longer a requirement for grades 1-8 but we do ask that a stain or long-wearing lip color 2-3 shades darker than the singer's natural color be applied at minimum.
- No bracelets, watches, earrings, or jewelry of any kind are permitted to be worn on stage.
- No nail polish (other than clear) is permitted. Fake nails should be removed by Wednesday 12/11 and may not be worn during any performance.
- **You must arrive ready to walk on stage. There will be no time to get ready in dressing rooms.**

THURSDAY INFORMATION

- On Thursday, December 12, singers will continue a longstanding tradition of performing for the 3rd graders of Escambia County Public Schools and local homeschool cohorts. There will be both a morning and an afternoon performance, with an audience in attendance for each.
- **This event requires an excusal from school.** A note has been provided and can be found on the Detail Sheet page of the PCC website.
- **It is your responsibility to appropriately communicate your child's absence to your child's school.**
- **ALL SINGERS** should **bring a lunch**.
- Thursday is our final costumed dress rehearsal, and professional photographers will be taking pictures. It is of the utmost importance that every singer adheres to the **performance readiness** requirements outlined above.
- Preparatory Choir is **not participating** in Thursday rehearsals or performances. Photos will also be taken on Wednesday night, so please be performance ready.

VOLUNTEERS

- **PCC-issued credentials** must be worn at all times. Do not attempt to enter the backstage area without your credentials.
- Please arrive **only for your scheduled volunteer assignment** (unless special permission has been given by Brooke Dykes, Performance Coordinator).
- Starting on Wednesday December 6, please wear **all black**.
- **Close-toed shoes** are always required while at the Saenger Theatre.
- **Do not bring non-PCC singers** to your volunteer assignment (this includes siblings).
- Remember that at all times you are subject to PCC's **Code of Conduct**. This is available for review on the PCC website.
